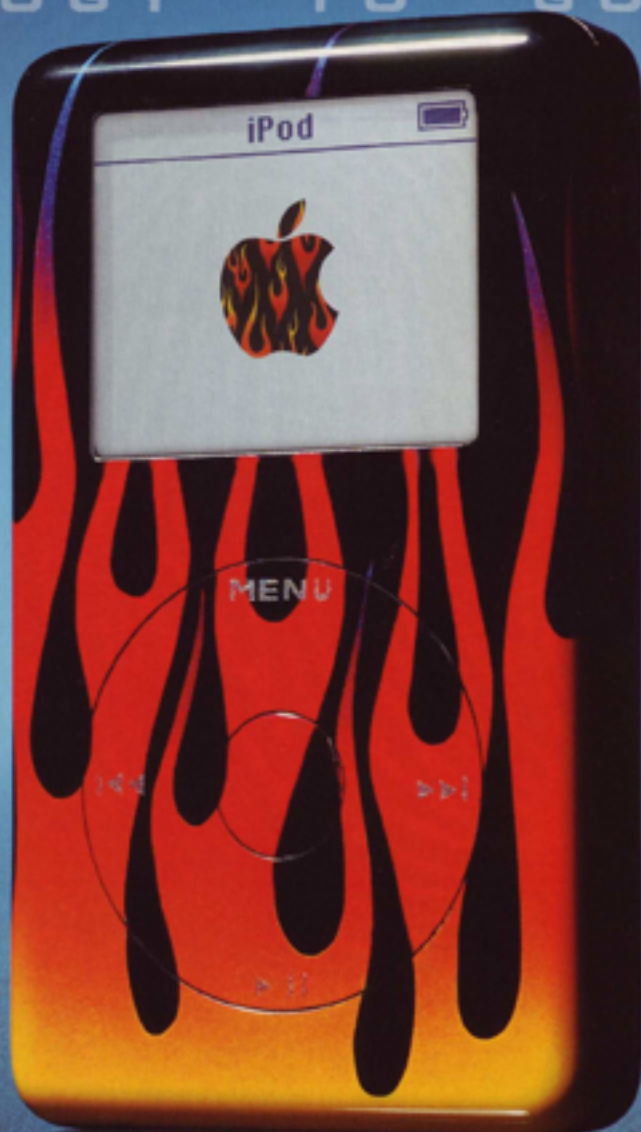

### iSkin Evo2

Dozens of companies sell form-fitting silicone iPod cases that provide all-over protection from scratches without adding too much bulk. For the most part these cases are similar, but minor refinements in the iSkin Evo2 make it tops in the category.

Two features really stand out. A bevel on Evo2 lets accessories that plug into the top of an iPod, such as Griffin's iTrip or iTalk, fit without taking the case off. Not every silicone case does this, and it's a major hassle to wrestle off the case to use some other widget. And the iSkin's screen protector is top-notch — superclear, with six soft contact points that keep it elevated above the iPod screen while anchoring it firmly in place.

The belt clip isn't our cup of tea, and you can't use your dock when the iPod is wrapped in an iSkin (although you can access the dock connector). But those are minor quibbles with what is generally a great product.
